Weather (in deg C)	Albania has a combination of a Mediterranean climate and a continental climate, with four distinct seasons. The climatic conditions are highly variable and modified locally by altitude and latitude. Its climate is strongly influenced by the Mediterranean Sea in the west, and the mountains that raise in every corner around the country. The monthly temperatures range between -1 °C in winter to 21.8 °C in summer. The warmest areas of the country are along the Adriatic and Ionian Sea Coasts. The coldest areas are positioned within the northern and eastern highlands. The highest temperature of 43.9 °C was recorded in Kuçovë on 18 July 1973. The lowest temperature of -29 °C was registered in the village of Shtyllë, Librazhd on 9 January 2017.
